*Proposed Sanitary Sewer System for the Enterprise Area*

*Greater Harrison County Public Service District has been given the authority by the Harrison County Commission to provide sanitary sewer service to all currently unserved areas of Harrison County. This District is in the Final Design stages of a project that will provide sanitary sewer service to the residents of the Enterprise area that currently utilize home septic systems or no treatment at all.*

*Greater Harrison County Public Service District is submitting project plans to seek funding to provide sewer service to approximately 380 customers in the Enterprise area. The sewage will be collected and transmitted via pumping stations to the Town of Worthington Wastewater Treatment Plant. The District is currently seeking rights-of-ways*

*The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) conducted a study in 2003 of the West Fork River in the area of Enterprise. The results of the study indicated approximately eleven sites of direct discharge of sewage into the river. Additionally representatives of the DEP conducted a walk-through of land adjacent to the river and located several areas where ponding waste water was evident. The situation created health hazards to the community as well as the environment.*

*The first facility plan was created in 2007 for the Enterprise Sanitary Sewer Project by The Thrasher Group of Bridgeport, WV. Since then, the Town of Worthington has completed upgrades to its Wastewater Treatment Plant which will allow for the additional flow from the Enterprise area. Additionally, the Facility plan was updated, and the project has now been designed. Public meetings have been held in Enterprise to discuss the Project and Rights of ways with the Property Owners and Residents. The District is committed to seeing this project through to fruition.
